To parent/carer and new members.

I would like to introduce Liberty and the services we offer within the community for children and young people with SEND.

Liberty have been established for 6 years and offer a variety of independent opportunities, including youth groups, sports programmes, Inclusive theatre, and dance sessions, all of which offer the chance for the young people to meet with their friends outside of school.

Liberty has professional youth workers and experienced SEND workers who facilitate all the sessions. Please see enclosed the programmes we have to offer and an overview of what they are

We work closely with parents/carers to try and address any barriers such as transport or medical needs. If you are interested in attending someone from our team will contact you and arrange a time to sit and go through your child's care plan and any additional barriers.

Presently, we offer transport on various days from Queens croft, Tamworth schools and Torc, including travel training. If there are several young people from one school or college then we will try and work alongside the establishment to try and develop a similar offer.
