Many thanks to those of you who have already used our Parent survey. This is based on the Ofsted Parent view survey and is a simple Microsoft Form for you to complete. We would like as many parents to complete the survey as possible so this gives an accurate picture of how our parent and carers currently view the school to help in our self evaluation. We will then report back to you with the results of the survey and our thoughts on our strengths and development areas.

On Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> November at 3:00 – 4:00pm, PCSO Jaswinder Gill will be holding a surgery in our main school office area. There will also be facility for a more private conversation if needed. We hope that this will give our community a chance to share any neighbourhood concerns with the local police.

This week we have also completed an attendance review of the pupils. We understand that this early in the year it can be difficult to gain an accurate view as a short absence can have a dramatic impact on attendance, however it is our duty to monitor and inform parents when attendance is below 90% and monitoring letters will be sent.

Our current whole school attendance is 95.4% which is in line with current national attendance for primary schools but below our whole school target of 97%.

On a final note, it has been brilliant to see so many parents from our reception classes on Thursday for their visit to the classroom and a short introduction to our reading scheme. We will be looking once again to extend opportunities for parents to engage in workshops and school visits as the year progresses.
