



Dear Parents,

It has been a very exciting day today with the issuing of our Learning Futures individual i-Pad devices for all Year 1 – Year 6 pupils.

We have explained to the pupils that these are a learning tool and the children are responsible for the devices coming into school daily – fully charged. Your child may also need help in connecting to your home Wi-Fi for full functionality. If you do not have Wi-Fi at home, children can download resources at school so that they can access them at home.

The devices are monitored and managed with children's safety in mind and many functionalities of a traditional i-pad are disabled – for example, we have disconnected the safari browser and replaced it with Smoothwall Browser to enable high level monitoring and filtering.

The children will have access to apps we use in school and we have also devised a short fun activity for the children to do at home this weekend: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Gwe8X4szVA8>

This has been shown in assembly and you can access the link on your own device. Unfortunately, as we have disabled YouTube the children wont be able to see this on their i-pads.

There will be further information for parents about how to manage the devices at home using an app called Jamf, which will give you as parents the ability to manage your child's use at home. Please be aware that the apps will not be able to be used between the hours of 8:00pm and 7:30am However, your child's device will need to be connected to your own Wi-Fi for these settings to take effect.

As with any infrastructure roll-out, there are sure to be some glitches in the systems and some of the iPads may need to update over the weekend, so please be patient.

If you haven't already checked, there is a wealth of information regarding the Learning Futures initiative on our school website, including information on jamf, FAQ and the acceptable use policies.
