Dear Parents and carers,

As we move into the final half term, I wanted to give an update regarding attendance. In the time of my headship here at Coton Green, attendance has been a strength. I truly believe that this is one of the main reasons our children achieve well, and it is a good indicator that our provision meets the needs of our children. It is a record we are proud of!

Our current whole school attendance is 95.8%, which is below our target. We have a duty to report to parents if their child reaches the persistent absence threshold of under 90% attendance and as such you may receive a monitoring letter to inform you of your child's current attendance.

If you are in need of support around attendance, please don't hesitate to contact us in school in confidence via the schools normal channel and a member of our pastoral or senior leadership team will be happy to contact you in confidence.

I have been notified that the LA will be running an attendance inspection and 'late gate' in the coming weeks. As a reminder, our school doors open at 8:45 and gates close at 8:55. Any child arriving after 8:55 will need to enter school via the main office and will be recorded as late. We are also unable to approve any leave of absence except for very exceptional circumstances.

On another note, I would like to pay tribute to our teaching teams in year 2 especially this week that have administered the KS1 tests over the past two weeks in such a way that children have been commenting that they are 'enjoying' their 'special quizzes'. These tests will inform our teacher assessment and will be reported to parents at the end of the year. Well done year 2!




The organisation of the Fair means that books may be bought immediately if you attend the Fair with your child. Should we sell out of popular titles, these may be ordered and received later.




