Thank you to all of you who have returned your information sheets to school, it is a great help to us when planning for next year. We are using this information and information from the nursey settings to help us to plan the classes for next year. We know you are awaiting further information regarding your child starting school in September. Unfortunately, we are unable to offer any stay and play dates in school before the end of the summer term due to our current Covid risk assessment.

We are planning to hold an online meeting to introduce ourselves and give you more information about the start of school for your child. We are planning to hold this on July 13th at 5pm via Zoom. More details to follow. In the meantime, please have a look at the school website https://cotongreen.staffs.sch.uk/ that has lots of information about uniforms, school meals and wraparound care.

Our plan is for all the children to have a stay and play session on Monday 6^{th} September. This will be a one-hour session when your child plus one parent/carer will be able to come to meet us and see their classroom.

On the Tuesday to Thursday of that week, your child will attend for either the morning or the afternoon only.

On Friday 10th September, all children will attend school in the morning and stay for lunch, with everybody going home at 1:30. After this, we would expect the vast majority of children to be in school full time.

We will be in touch before the meeting to tell you your child's class teacher, colour team, and which sessions your child will attend for the first week.
