Dear Parents and Carers,

As we come to the end of a long half term we should be mindful of the successes we have achieved in getting all children back into school and working hard to catch up on lost time.

School has looked very different and it is so challenging for children to be isolated within their class bubbles when we have been used to working across year groups and celebrating our achievements together.

However, due to the hard work and planning that has gone into our mitigation of risk for Covid-19, with support and expertise from within the ATLP, we have been able to limit the learning loss of children when positive cases have been identified.

Today we welcomed back Sycamore class and it was so lovely to see that they had worked so hard and had in effect kept up with their peers in school. I did chuckle when one unnamed child commented that it was far from a holiday!!! I would like to place my thanks to Mr Newton and Mrs Shipman who have worked in isolation to ensure that Sycamore class were learning. Of course I'm sure parents and carers also helped significantly and would like to express my thanks for your support too.

Other children isolating across school have also been provided with work and, whilst not the same as being in school, I have nothing but admiration for all involved in limiting the loss of learning due to enforced absences.

Our attendance levels (other than enforced isolations) are outstanding. This is really helping children catch up lost learning and bridge the gap to new learning.

We have also implemented the RWI phonics scheme during this first half term and will be extending this to reading after half term. Again I have to praise the dedication of our teaching team, often attending 2 sessions per week after school for training purposes to ensure the best delivery possible for your children.

I have also been touched by the kind positive messages received, often by email to office@cotongreen.staffs.sch.uk It has been really good to be able to share these and boosted morale in school in difficult times. We are really lucky to have such dedicated staff who have been determined to make things work in these difficult times and these messages have been gratefully received.

Our trial of hot meals has gone really well. We have been able to maintain class bubbles in two distinct sittings with all the appropriate controls to allow our youngest children to eat in the hall. The older children have enjoyed their grab bag hot lunches and have been able to eat these in their class bubbles, all with carefully controlled logistics to reduce contacts and maintain bubble security. We are going to a full hot meal menu on our return to school. The cost will be £2.35 per meal, a small price increase that ATLP have worked hard to minimise.

Thanks for your continued support. Enjoy half term and see you back on Monday November 2nd, fresh and raring for more fabulous learning!
