



Procedures for inclement weather

Snow fall does not trigger a closure of a school and we are aware of the impact snow can have on travel. Therefore, we will make allowances for lateness and arrangements for early pickups to allow for any severe travel disruption as a result of inclement weather.

However, in extreme cases there may be no other alternative than to close, or part close the school. In such an event notification will be available through a number of sources, however our most efficient would be to use our facility to send texts and emails to you (please ensure we have your email and mobile number).

We would endeavour to make any such decision as early as possible and would only close as a last resort.
