Please be aware school cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage.

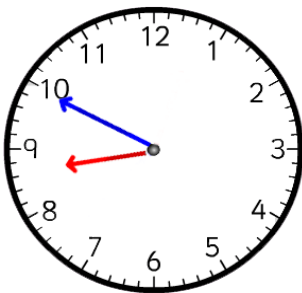
## REMINDER
