### **Tickets for Schools**

I am delighted to tell you we are participating in the Tickets for Schools scheme launched by Aston Villa Football Club. The scheme enables pupils to attend a home Premier League football match at Villa Park for just £1.

### **Taking Part**

If you are interested in taking part in Tickets for Schools, we will issue your child with a voucher for £1. This can be redeemed at the Aston Villa ticket office for an under 12 match ticket at a home Barclays Premier League football match. Please note people may need to already have a booking history to purchase tickets for category A games. Your child can attend up to 10 football matches each football season with the Tickets for Schools scheme. Vouchers can be redeemed in person at the Aston Villa ticket office in person or by calling 0800 612 0970 and quoting the voucher number.

The great thing for Coton Green Primary is that tickets are being donated to us free of charge by Aston Villa. As a result, all funds generated from the sale of vouchers will go directly into school funds!

### Supervision

So that children are appropriately supervised, children taking part in this offer must be accompanied to Villa Park by an adult and an adult can accompany up to 4 children. Aston Villa will sell one match ticket per voucher to an accompanying adult at reduced prices £15/£20 (price dependent on match category), or an accompanying adult can also be a current Aston Villa season ticket holder.

# TOP TEN TIPS TO ENJOY A FOOTBALL MATCH

- 1. Check the weather report before you leave home and dress accordingly as you will be in the open air throughout the match.
- 2. If you have never been to a football match before you will need to understand that it is a very noisy place, 42,000 people can create quite a noise and smaller children might wish to wear ear muffs.
- 3. Traffic will be very heavy so plan your journey to and from Villa Park. You can find travel information at www.avfc.co.uk in the "Villa Park" section, including information on parking, public transport and the Villa special bus service.
- 4. You also need to understand that whilst not condoned by the Club in anyway, some people in the audience may use language that is unacceptable so you may wish to consider who you bring to the match.
- 5. Remember that matches with an evening kick-off might finish a bit late for younger children.

- 6. As you will have children with you, make sure they have your emergency contact details with them, in case you become separated. Once you are at your seats, identify the nearest 'Tickets for Schools' support worker and stand steward in case you need help.
- 7. When you get to Villa Park identify a place outside Villa Park (for example the big screen outside North Stand or the car park outside the Holte Pub) as a place to meet if you accidentally get separated. Do the same once you are inside Villa Park and identify where the nearest fire exit is.
- 8. Ensure that nobody within your group wears colours/kit of the away team as these tickets are for the home areas and it could cause problems.
- 9. There are food kiosks in and outside Villa Park which are open before and during the match but not afterwards so ensure you get your warm drinks when you can.
- 10. If you wish to visit the Club's retail store, it will be open well before the match but not always after night matches. Souvenir programmes can be purchased from the vendors all around Villa Park.
