Dear Learning Family

I would like to wish all of our Year 6 cohort the very best of luck for next week's SATS. Their work ethic over the last few weeks, and indeed over the whole of their time at Coton Green, has been terrific and the staffs' dedication in giving them their best chance in these tests has been first-class. The children are ready and eager, and I believe that it is important that they have a full weekend of rest before the tests start on Monday.

Next week, the staff have organised an 8:00am breakfast club for the Year 6 children where they can come in early, have some breakfast and be with their teachers and friends before the tests. In the past, this has really helped the children with their nerves and got the children in the right frame of mind for the tests. It is important that the children realise that these tests are just a snapshot of what they have achieved in their time here and that they do not tell the whole story — they do not reflect the achievements of our children in sport or music and they do not reflect how they have blossomed as independent and curious learners. As you know, we value all these achievements equally at Coton Green. All we ask next week is that they give the tests their best shot!

Other year groups across school too will be completing assessment tests. We have done our best to ensure that these are as low key as possible for the children, as these tests are only designed to inform teachers about how well the children are doing so that the teachers can pull evidence from other sources to make their final teacher assessments for the year.

Finally, could I advise parents that, if they order lunches at the hatch, the hall must be cleared by 9:00am as it is being used for Year 6 SATs. Alternatively, parents can complete menus and hand in to their child's class teacher or the office.


