We are piloting this from Monday 14th September until the end of March in the first instance.

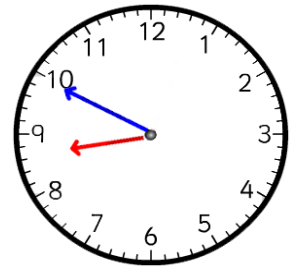
This will run Monday to Friday 3.30 – 5.30pm.

Reminder - Pupil Premium -----What is it?

Pupil Premium funding is awarded to the school to help provide extra opportunities for those eligible for Free School Meals (FSM), or who have been within the last six years, those who have ever been in care, and the children of service personnel. This money is vital to the school.

A little known fact is that parents can apply even if they don't want to take up free school meals (over £300 of free meals!), as this funding can assist your child in many other ways, from extra small group tuition to assistance with school trips such as Chasewater.

So that we can benefit from this extra funding, please contact the school office who will give you any further information that you may need to apply.
