



Dear Learning Family,

Next week marks our yearly assessments in year 6. The children will be undertaking a series of tests next week that include reading, grammar, spelling and punctuation and mathematics. A letter containing the time table and other details has been sent home to the Year 6 children.

In addition, our Year 2 children will be undertaking their SATS tests during the month of May; however, these tests are used internally to check standards and inform the overall teacher assessment reported at the end of the year.

Early next half term, other year groups too will be carrying out standardised tests as a check on attainment and progress. We will use this information as part of our overall teacher assessment. The outcomes of these assessments will be reported in our annual reports which will be delivered in the final weeks of the academic year.

Similar to this time last year, I have seen some negative reports about testing in the media recently, and I would like to stress testing is only part of Coton Green's Assessment Policy. We are very proud of our broad and balanced curriculum and the wide and varied opportunities that our teaching team work hard to arrange for the children. Ofsted recognised our curriculum as a clear strength and in fact we have increased our opportunities this year, with more visits, trips and special curriculum events. Achievements in many other subject disciplines are highly-regarded and celebrated in school, as we believe these are just as important as test results.

Our children, teachers and you as parents have worked so hard in preparing for these up-coming tests and we are delighted with all our children's efforts. Their commitment to 'be the best that they can possibly be' is exceptional. Next week, our Year 6 will be able to come to school from 8:00 with free toast so that they can be with their teachers and friends to allay any nerves. I wish all our children completing the tests over the next few weeks all the very best.

I have advised them that all we ask them for is their own personal best and to make the most of the weekend despite the weather! I will certainly be taking this advice with my own daughter this weekend, who is also in Year 6. I will be telling her how proud I am of her hard work, not to worry about the tests and to just try her best. We have also planned a family outing to take her mind off things.

Finally, could I advise parents that if they order lunches at the hatch, the hall must be cleared by 9:00 on Monday, as it is being used for Year 6 SATS. Alternatively, parents can complete any menus and hand in to their child's teacher or the office.
