Dear Parents / Carers

I am writing to you after a wonderful term of events here at Coton Green. The Easter Bonnet Parades this week were delightful and it was so lovely to see so many of you enjoying the parades in school. The children obviously enjoyed making their bonnets and showing them off during the parade. The KS2 children also designed their own eggs. This year the entries were absolutely amazing and it was great to see such creative work completed by the children at home. I know that the judges found it extremely difficult to choose from each class as the standard was so high. Well done to all who took part.

Our Sport Relief events over the last few weeks saw over 400 children, staff and parents complete a sponsored mile around the local area and the hiring of Kingsbury swimming pool for 25 children to swim almost 20 miles – a fantastic achievement. The school council also sold Sports Relief Merchandise and organised Sainsbury's to come and sell a wider collection. The Coton Green Learning Family should be extremely proud of their efforts and we are still counting the donations and sponsorship. We will of course let you know our final total but early indications suggest a total of around $\pm 1,000$.

Here at Coton Green we are proud of our commitment to have a broad and balanced curriculum and our commitment to music has been recognised by the award of Music Mark. This term has seen us have the opportunity for Year 4 to work with a professional Choir Master Robin Morton and Musician Cathy Lamb over a 12 week period culminating in an evening performance at St Editha's Church in Tamworth. Here we were joined by children from Ankermoor and William MacGregor Primary Schools and the Lichfield choristers to perform a number of songs. The performance was magical and the behaviour of the children, as always was first class. Many thanks for your support of this very special event.


This Tuesday we were also treated to a music concert by our peripatetic music teachers which the pupils also thoroughly enjoyed. If you are interested in your child having small group instrumental tuition, please see Mrs Hall as we currently have some vacancies for Violin and Cello.

We also value learning outside the classroom and to complement this we have recently identified an area in school to eventually become a Forest School. We recently received over 200 trees from Tanglewood and worked with the forestry commission to plant them with the children. We have had school curriculum trips to the Botanical Gardens for Years 5 and 6 and The River Trent Education Centre at Wolseley Bridge for Years 3 and 4. Years 1 and 2 visited Wigginton Park for an outdoor workshop organised by the Tamworth Wildlife Trust. The School Council and Year 1 and 2 also completed a 'Clean for the Queen' of our school perimeter. In addition our Year 5 and 6 have had many visits to the local secondary schools including a Year 5 secondary experience day at Rawlett and a performance of Annie at QEMS Landau Forte. I would like to say a thank-you to all the staff who work so very hard behind the scenes to make these trips possible. Also, a large thanks to you our parents /carers who always volunteer in large numbers.

I would also like to thank the children, who behave so well. I get so many compliments about our children's behaviour when on school visits, from visitors and at events and I am always so proud in the way the children represent the school.

All that remains for me to do is to wish you all a happy Easter break, stay safe and come back refreshed for another busy but exciting term of learning.

We require approachable, friendly and flexible members of staff one to work for 6.25 hours per week, 12.15 - 1.30pm Monday to Friday and one casual to work the same hours but on an adhoc basis as and when required. The successful applicants will be expected to:

- Working under the direction and instruction of senior staff provide the care of the children during the school lunch break.
- Escorting pupils to and from the school dining room

- Summoning help, where necessary, in case of injury or illness and providing basic first aid for minor injuries (for which training will be available)
