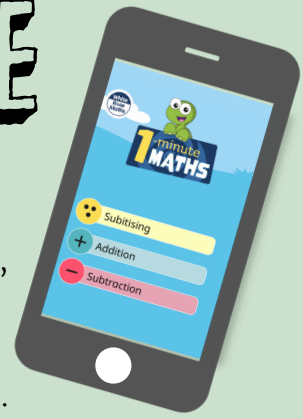


MATHS @ HOME



In school, we use a range of things to help children become confident in their mathematical understanding such as models, manipulatives and methods.

TTRS

WHO IS IT FOR?

Every child in Years 1-6 will have a TTRS log in. However, Year 1 will not begin using this app until they have been taught multiplication in school. Children in Y2-6 will have regular opportunities in school to use TTRS.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

TTRS gives children the opportunity to develop fast recall of multiplication and division facts. The children will be set specific times tables by their teacher and will be presented with randomly-generated calculations to answer. This child-friendly app provides an engaging platform for children to learn, play and 'battle'.

A Battle will be set up by school teachers. Throughout the school year, various Battles will take place between classes and year groups. Here, the children compete to get as many points (correct answers) as possible to be crowned the winners.

1-Minute Maths

WHO IS IT FOR?

This first version of the app is aimed at Key Stage 1 pupils, and focuses on adding, subtracting, multiplication and subitising.

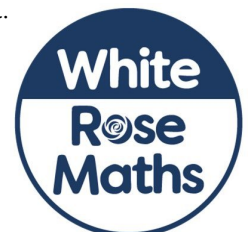
HOW DOES IT WORK?

1-Minute Maths offers children engaging and easily accessible practice in basic number. There's no specific route or starting point. Having chosen a topic, each user answers a series of randomly generated questions (a different set of questions every time means they learn the concept, not a sequence of answers).

When the one minute's up, the questions are automatically marked and presented on a breakdown screen, giving instant feedback on how they've done. If they're struggling with a question, a 'Hint' button reformats the question as a familiar manipulative display that mirrors the approaches used in lessons at Coton Green.
