



Year 1 Curriculum Map 2023-24 Spring Term: Information for parents

Art **Design and Technology** How to paint and print: Mechanical Systems: wheels and axles

To use basic painting materials independently (washing and wiping your brush, using a paint brush with care).

Children will be investigating the following questions:

- How does a wheel work?
- Can I make a basic moving vehicle with wheels and axels?
- Which wheel and axel are the most effective?
- Can I make a final design?
- How effective is my vehicle?

Digital Painting

Children will be investigating the following questions:

- 1. How can we paint using computers?
- 2. How can we create digital images using shapes and lines?
- 3. What are the appropriate tools to use to re-create a picture in the style of a chosen artist?
- 4. Why did I choose to use this specific tool?
- 5. How can I create a digital picture using a pointillist approach?
- 6. What are the similarities and differences between computer art and paintings?

Musical Elements – London's Burning

Children will be investigating the following questions:

- 1. Can I identify repeated sound patterns in a song?
- 2. How can I keep in time? Can I respond to signals for starting and stopping?
- 3. Can I control the different sounds I make with my voice?
- 4. How can I add sound effects to a poem?
- 5. Can I perform a 'round' song?
- 6. Can I use musical vocabulary to make useful comments on performances and compositions?

Worship

How and why do Christians and Hindus worship

Children will explore who they belong to and what symbols represent them. They will be recalling what a Christian and Hindu is from prior learning and learning about how they worship. Children will identify key symbols, actions and rituals used during Christian worship and learning when Hindus worship and which artefacts are used. They will be identifying similarities and differences between Hindu and Christian worship.

Lent and Holi

What are the similarities and differences between Lent and Holi?

Children will be discussing whether they celebrate Easter and if so, how. They will learn what Lent is and why Christians take part in it. Children will identify challenges Christian's face during Lent too. Children will also learn the Easter story and the ancient story of Holi. They will be exploring how Holi is celebrated across the world.
